

CONTEXT



As of today, India stands at the crossroads in its battle against HIV/AIDS. Concerted policies and strategic interventions have led to significant decline in annual new infections (ANI) and AIDS related deaths (ARD) in India. Yet, the nation is still far from ending AIDS as a public health threat.



The vertical transmission rate for HIV is 24% PMTCT need - 20,612

Final MTCT Rate of HIV - 24.25%

Top 3 states accounting for the highest PMTCT need are Maharashtra (12.9%), Bihar (11.9%), and Uttar Pradesh (10.6%).

In 2021, the top three States with the highest adult HIV prevalence are Mizoram (2.70%), Nagaland (1.36%), and Manipur (1.05%) in the north-east region. Other States with HIV prevalence higher than the national average (0.21%) are Andhra Pradesh (0.67%), Telangana (0.47%), Karnataka (0.46%) in the southern region, Meghalaya (0.42%) in the north-east region and Maharashtra (0.33%) in the western region. Delhi, Goa, and Puducherry have adult HIV prevalence estimated at 0.31% each.

Children & HIV/AIDS

A well-known and calamitous effect of HIV/AIDS is the vast numbers of children orphaned by the disease. These children endure overwhelming and largely unmitigated losses. Neither words nor statistics can adequately capture the human tragedy of children grieving for dying or dead parents, stigmatized by society through association with HIV/AIDS, plunged into economic crisis and insecurity by their parents' death and struggling without services or support systems in impoverished communities.

Not only orphans, socio-cultural factors such as low health literacy, poverty, HIV-related stigma, limited health infrastructure, gender norms, and traditional practices can present complex challenges to the delivery and expansion of HIV prevention, care, and treatment services to CLHA hailing from impoverished communities.

DESIRE Society was founded 2004 the vear and in registered in 2005 as a Not For Profit organization under the Andhra Pradesh Societies Registration Act, 2001 (Act no 35 or, 2001). The organization established was to give orphan and vulnerable children (OVC) the care they deserve. The society focuses Children living on with **HIV/AIDS** (CLHA). children abandoned by one or both children of parents, sex workers, truck drivers and children who have been abused & belong to poor socio-economic conditions. Started in Hyderabad, DESIRE Society today operates in five states of India with high HIV prevalence-Maharashtra. Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Telangana and Delhi-NCR. DESIRE has grown into India's leading NGO catering to CLHA and other OVC.

DESIRE's core programmes are-Institutional Care Home, Child Nutrition & Health Care Camp and Summer Camp.


Organizational Effectiveness


INSTITUTIONAL CARE HOME

Our Homes: Nests of Hope

DESIRE Society initiated the concept of Institutional Care homes to provide comprehensive care to CLHA. DESIRE institutional homes nurture children with individual care and family environment. We provide children a warm loving environment where they feel accepted and not judged, feel a sense of freedom, feel a sense of possibility, and most importantly feel a sense of belongingness to country. In DESIRE homes children are cared for in a loving and safe family environment, with safe places to play, they are encouraged to develop positive relationships and participate in decisions that affect their lives. We prepare our children to become self-confident and self-reliant adults in the long run.

Our Comprehensive, Customized, Critical and Compassionate services are designed to positively affect emotional functioning, social functioning, selfesteem, physical well-being of children. We have hope and a vision for their future.

Our child well-being targets provide a clear framework for measuring results on some of the core aspects of our work – in health and nutrition, education, child protection and sense of purpose and worth.



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Our Children: Special in own unique ways

Most of our CLHA are OVCs- orphans, semi-orphans, children abandoned by one or both parents, children of sex workers, truck drivers, victims of children from abuse. and poor families. Our care homes have children upto 18 years. Bevond 18 years, the after care home structure is established in Hyderabad. Today, we are proud to say that many of our "DESIRE" children are pursuing higher education, technical and joboriented courses while enlisted in after care home system.

CHILD NUTRITION & HEALTH CARE

Total Beneficiaries reached: 900 CLHA

Socio-cultural factors such as low health literacy, poverty, HIV-related stigma, limited health infrastructure, gender norms, and traditional practices can present complex challenges to the delivery and expansion of HIV prevention, care, and treatment services to CLHA.

A CD 4 cell estimation test is performed assess the stage of disease to progression and treatment of CLHA. The importance of our Child Nutrition and Health Care Programme is to diagnose in children and HIV/AIDS provide treatment. The impact of the treatment can be seen within few months. There is a dramatic positive change in the physical condition with the child putting on weight, looking healthier and more cheerful, as he/she resumes a normal life.



DESIRE Society reaches out to CLHA from disadvantaged communities & provide the following services:

- Diagnostics and related technologies for HIV/AIDS, related opportunistic infections & other conditions
- Enumeration of CD4 cells in HIV children monitored
- Initiation of ART & other drugs
- · Psychosocial support
- Monthly Supplementary Nutrition Kits



We conduct health camps to raise awareness against the stigma surrounding HIV and AIDS, disseminate information on the disease and how to combat it. We diagnose HIV infections in infants and children & convince parents of HIV positive children to avail medical treatments that can dramatically enhance their children's quality of life and chances of survival. We also provide travel and logistical support for the children and their parents.

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Like every year, summer camps were organized by DESIRE Society in the month of June across all the cities in which it operates. Magic show, puppet show, yoga, tattoo art, dance show, fashion show, air balloon sliding, toy car riding, camel riding and trampolining were organized to entertain the participating children.

We schedule rest times, mix up high and low-energy activities and manage medication and treatment times. Our medical teams coordinate with health care providers, parents and caregivers to reduce the risk of health challenges and keep children healthy and safe. Much of the health-related work happens in the background so that campers can have a joyful camp experience.





Our camps are recreation focused and act as ideal platform for children to learn and have fun at the same time. Activities such as outdoor games, sports, music, arts and crafts, talent shows, educational programmes aimed at building life skills of children are conducted at the camps. Our camps enable children to develop confidence, independence, social skills, leadership skills, empathy and inspire them to try new things.

Living with a serious medical condition like HIV/AIDS can be frightening and isolating for children. So we organize these summer camps to create opportunities for CLHA to think beyond serious illness and discover joy, confidence and a new world of possibilities.




